Sign company expanding in Islandia

M&M Awning and Sign has purchased a 23,000-square-foot industrial building next door to its Islandia headquarters for \$2.4 million.

The property is located on 1.18 acres at 190-200 Oval Drive.

The company had outgrown its existing 20,000-square-foot building at 180 Oval Drive, which was bought for \$1.725 million in June 2014. M&M will now use both properties for its expanding operations.
